

94-97 Dash Panel Installation Instructions

1. While it is possible to install the dash repair panel with the dashboard installed in the car, it's much easier with the dashboard removed.



2. First, remove the VIN tag by drilling out the two rivets. The VIN is located at several other places on the car, so you don't need to reuse it. But if you desire, we've included two extra rivets so you can reattach it to the new panel.



- 3. Line up the panel on the dash, and mark the hole locations. Drill out holes with an 1/8" drill bit.
- 4. While not required, we recommend snipping out the old defrost vent fins, so they will not be visible through the new vent holes. A pair of side-cutters works well.

5. Using the included rivets, start in the center and work outwards, riveting the panel down.



6. Reinstall the dash and enjoy! As an optional step, install a thin strip of foam on the leading edge of the dash before re-installing. This will keep the dash from rattling against the windshield.
